California Correctional Health Care Services (CCHCS) provides care that includes medical, dental and mental health services to California’s prison inmate population at all 35 California Department of Corrections and Rehabilitation (CDCR) institutions statewide.

Facts & Figures

- Annual inmate health care costs Fiscal Year 2018-19: \$26,275
- There have been no preventable deaths since 2012
- The number of possible preventable deaths has trended downward since 2007.
- Acuity of inmate-patients for our 35 institutions (as of September 2018):
 - 16,718 high-medical acuity
 - 43,266 medium-medical acuity
 - 63,142 low-medical acuity
