## **Community Resources**

#### Enhanced Care Management Lead Care Manager (Lead Care Manager)

A Lead Care Manager is someone in the community who helps create a Reentry Care Plan for your needs after release. They assist with doctor visits, housing, mental health care, and other support services. Think of them as your go-to resource for health and social services.

#### **County Behavioral Health Department**

Offers mental health and substance use treatment, along with other support services.

#### Transition Case Management Program Benefit Worker (BW)

Enrolls you for benefits like Medi-Cal, Social Security, or Veterans Administration benefits.

## Institution Resources

#### **Pre-Release Care Coordination Team**

This team works in your institution to help arrange your health care needs after release and connects you with your community Lead Care Manager.

#### ISUDT Behavioral Health Clinician (Complex Care Unit)

A clinician who evaluates whether you could benefit from substance use treatment after release.

#### **ISUDT Resource Nurse**

Helps plan for your release by assessing your health needs, coordinating care, and ensuring your Reentry Care Plan is in place.

#### Institutional Mental Health Pre-Release Coordinator (IMHPC)

If you're receiving mental health services at the institution, this clinician works with your treatment team, the Pre-Release Care Coordination Team, and community partners to ensure you continue receiving care after release.

### Parole Services Associate (PSA)

Gathers information through interviews and reviews of your central file to create a reentry plan before your release. They connect you with local reentry programs and community services to support your transition.
