California Code of Regulations, Title 15, Division 3, Adult Institutions, Programs, and Parole

Chapter 2. Rules and Regulations of Health Care Services

Article 1. Health Care Definitions

Section 3999.98 is amended to incorporate in alphabetical order the following, and all other text within this section remains the same:

Section 3999.98. Definitions.

Death Mortality Review means a type of review analysis conducted completed by a Nurse Consultant Program Review staff and a physician or Advanced Practice Provider in which assesses the quality and appropriateness of nursing health care, nursing practice issues, best practices, and factors that may have significantly impacted the quality of a patient care, thereby contributing received prior to the death of a patient is assessed and best practices and opportunities for improvement are identified.

Article 2. Health Care Program Governance

Section 3999.109 is amended to read:

3999.109. Clinical Documentation and Decision Support Guidelines Committee.

(a) The <u>California Department of Corrections and Rehabilitation</u> Department shall maintain a Clinical <u>Documentation and Decision Support Guidelines</u> Committee <u>responsible for overseeing</u> the research and development or the adaptation of existing evidence-based standards of care, <u>facilitating the dissemination of updated clinical guidance</u>, and monitoring and evaluating <u>implementation of standards of care</u> that promotes specific guidelines in the application of proven prevention, diagnosis and treatment strategies, and the overall practice of evidence-based medicine.

Section 3999.114. Death Mortality Reporting and Review and Reporting.

- (a) The <u>California</u> Department <u>of Corrections and Rehabilitation (CDCR)</u> shall <u>maintain a</u> <u>Death Reporting and Review Program responsible for completeing</u> an independent review of every <u>patient</u> death <u>which occurs within the Department</u> of individuals in its custody.
- (b) The Department shall maintain a Death Review Committee which shall discuss all reports and the listed findings; make referrals to the appropriate peer review committees; vote on preventability; determine causes of death; and provide notifications to headquarters programs /committees.
- (b) CDCR shall post the information regarding the death of any person in departmental custody on its public website pursuant to Penal Code section 10008.

3999.116. Systemwide Pharmacy and Therapeutics Committee.

- (a) The California Department of Corrections and Rehabilitation's (CDCR) Systemwide Pharmacy and Therapeutics (P&T) Committee shall provide oversight is responsible for providing oversight to Pharmacy Services at all CDCR institutions—and the approval of policies and procedures related to all aspects of medication use within the Department including, but not limited to:
- (b) The Systemwide P&T Committee is responsible for the approval of policies and procedures related to all aspects of medication use within the Department including, but not limited to:
- (1) Approving medications <u>including standardizing the strengths and dosage forms for medications used across institutions.</u>
- (2) Reviewing procurement and medication selection processes to ensure promote cost-effective management.
 - (3) Conducting regular therapeutic category reviews for medications.
