



### Medically Necessary, Potentially Sterilizing Procedures Performed in 2023

As required by law (Penal Code Section 3440), the following medically necessary, potentially sterilizing procedures were performed in calendar year 2023. This information includes age, race, medical necessity and procedure performed on the patient.

39	White	Malignant neoplasm of unspecified site of right female breast	Laparoscopy, surgical; with removal of adnexal structures.	Medically necessary. Diagnosis of breast cancer (invasive ductal carcinoma insitu) with BRCA1 positive, high risk of developing ovarian cancer in the future. Not intended for sterilization.
40	Hispanic	Hypertrophy of uterus	Supracervical abdominal hysterectomy with or without removal of tube(s), with or without removal of ovary(s).	Medically necessary. Symptomatic enlarged uterus (17x18x10cm) and large ovarian cyst (6cm). Not intended for sterilization.
38	Hispanic	Carcinoma in situ of cervix, unspecified	Vaginal hysterectomy for uterus 250g or less with removal of tube(s) and/or ovary(s).	Medically necessary. History of recurrent CIN 3. High risk of developing cervical cancer. Not intended for sterilization.
27	Hispanic	Benign neoplasm of right ovary	Laparoscopy, surgical; with removal of adnexal structures.	Medically necessary. Symptomatic right Ovarian Dermoid (5.2x4.4cm). High risk of right ovarian torsion. No risk of sterilization.
38	Hispanic	Subserosal leiomyoma of uterus	Total hysterectomy.	Medically necessary. Symptomatic large uterine fibroid (20x16x20cm). Failed medical treatment. Not intended for sterilization.
43	Black	Intramural leiomyoma of Uterus	Total hysterectomy.	Medical necessary. Symptomatic enlarged uterus (17x13x17cm). Failed medical treatment. Not intended for sterilization.
45	White	Benign neoplasm of left ovary	Laparoscopy, surgical; with removal of adnexal structures.	Medically necessary. Symptomatic mature teratoma. Failed medical treatment. No risk of sterilization.

47	Black	Abnormal uterine and vaginal bleeding, unspecified	Total hysterectomy.	Medically necessary. Symptomatic large uterine fibroids largest 6.7x6.7x6.9cm. Failed medical treatment. Not intended for sterilization.
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
